"Celebrate the Lord of the Nations"

Greetings in the name of the LORD! I pray that all is well with you, with your families, with your congregations, with your LWML societies, with your LWML zones, and with the LA-MS LWML District. "May mercy, peace, and love be multiplied to you." (Jude 1:2) As you know, our theme for this next biennium is drawn from Psalm 33, verses twelve and thirteen, which read:

¹² Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, the people whom he has chosen as his heritage!¹³ The LORD looks down from heaven; he sees all the children of man; (Psalm 33:12-13, ESV)

When we read the word, "*LORD*", in the ESV translation, we should also have in mind that this is the personal name of God, "YHWH", typically pronounced Yahweh, that he revealed to Moses at the burning bush in Exodus 3:14-15. As such, this is the name of the one true God, the triune God – The Father, Son & Holy Spirit. So, with that in mind, we could rewrite of our theme verses as:

¹² Blessed is the nation whose God is [YHWH], the people whom he has chosen as his heritage!¹³ [YHWH] looks down from heaven; he sees all the children of man; (Psalm33:12-13)

or

¹² Blessed is the nation whose God is [the one true God, the triune God - the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit], the people whom he has chosen as his heritage!¹³ [The one true God, the triune God - the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit] looks down from heaven; he sees all the children of man; (Psalm 33:12-13)

In our last newsletter, I focused on the work of God the Father. In this newsletter, I will focus on the work of the Second Person of the Holy Trinity, God the Son.

Father, **Son**, and Holy Spirit], the people whom he has chosen as his heritage!¹³ The LORD [one true God, the triune **God** – **the** Father, **Son**, and Holy Spirit] looks down from heaven; he sees all the children of man; (Psalm 33:12-13)

When it comes to the work of God the Son as it is identified in the Second Article of the Creed, "And in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.", we were taught in Dr. Luther's Small Catechism to believe and confess the following:

I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord,

who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with HIs innocent suffering and death,

that I may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness,

just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity.

This is most certainly true.

"Blessed is the nation", blessed are you, whose God is YHWH, the triune God. Blessed are you because the God the Son took on human flesh to be with us, our Immanuel (Mt. 1:23), to save us from our sins, our Lord Jesus (Mt. 1:21). And this is why we celebrate the LORD of the nations in our midst and in the world around us, remembering that while we were enemies of God and couldn't do anything to please Him (Rom. 8:7-8), God sent His Son into the world, the one with whom He is well pleased, to reconcile the world to Himself (2 Cor. 5:18-19). This is why we continue to joyfully proclaim Christ, the Light of the World, into this world of darkness "For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ." (2 Cor. 4:6) We are, as Jesus said, "the light of the world" (Mt. 5:14) who continue to "proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His *marvelous light*" (1Pet. 2:9) that all may come to the knowledge of the truth and be saved (1Tim. 2:4) through the power of the Holy Spirit. And while, at times, it might seem like the darkness is overcoming the light, I am reminded of the words of Saint John in chapter one of his Gospel account in verse five: "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." And while these words are about Jesus, I believe that they are also about His church (1 Thess. 4:18) and His Means of Grace - His Word and Sacraments (Ps. 119:105, 1 Cor. 11:23-26).

"Blessed is the nation", blessed are you, whose God is YHWH, the triune God. Blessed are you because "while you were weak", God the Son in the flesh, Christ Jesus, "died for the ungodly" (Rom. 5:6). Blessed are you because "while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Rom. 5:8) Blessed are you because "while we were enemies of God we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son". (Rom 5:10a) And blessed are you **"much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by His life."** (Rom. 5:10b) And this this is why we celebrate the LORD of the nations in our midst and in the world around us, remembering and trusting in our Lord's promise. "if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved. For the Scripture says, "Everyone who believes in him will not be put to shame.""(Rom. 10:9-12) And while it can be difficult, at times, to see how God is doing these things in this fallen broken world that we live in, I am reminded of the words of the Lord in Isaiah, chapter fifty-five, verses ten and eleven: "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it."

"Blessed is the nation", blessed are you, whose God is YHWH, the triune God. Blessed are you because God the Son in the flesh, Christ Jesus, has made you part of His kingdom through faith and baptism (Mk. 16:16a, 1 Pet. 3:21) as you were baptized into Christ's death and resurrection (Rom. 6:4-5). Blessed are you because your "old self was crucified with Him in order that the body of sin might be brought to nothing, so that we would no longer be enslaved to sin." (Rom. 5:6) Blessed are you because you have "died with Christ", and you now "also live with Him". (Rom. 6:9) Blessed are you because "[o]nce you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy." (1 Pet. 2:10) And this is why we celebrate the Lord of the nations in our midst and in the world around us, remembering, knowing, and trusting that our Lord has the power and ability to take what is spiritually blind (1 Cor. 2:14) and dead in its sins and trespasses (Eph. 2:1) and give it new life in Christ Jesus (Eph. 2:4-5). And while it can be difficult, at times, to see the fruits of God's work in this culture that we live in, I am reminded of the words of the Apostle Paul in Romans, chapter seven, verses twentyfour and twenty-five: "Wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord!"

May the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of all mercies and God all comfort be with you now and always.
